At least 30% of grade 3-8 students will score proficient/advanced on the ELA PSSA.

At least 18% of grade 3 students will score proficient/advanced on the ELA PSSA.

At least 14% of grade 3-8 students will score proficient/advanced on the Math PSSA.

At least 60% of all students will attend school 90% of days or more.

At least 98% of students will have zero out-of-school suspensions.
